PURPOSE: Food trucks present a unique hazard for events that are not covered in the adopted codes. The purpose of this policy is to identify the standard to which these hazards shall be inspected.

SCOPE: This policy shall apply to all food trucks located inside the Town limits.

RESPONSIBILITY: The Chief Fire Marshal assumes overall responsibility for the inspection program and to create policy from 2015 IFC 104.1. The Chief Fire Marshal is responsible for identifying the standard or requirements to be used during inspections. Fire inspectors are responsible for conducting, completing and updating pre fire surveys, and forwarding this information to the fire marshal.

PROCEDURE: Food trucks shall meet and be inspected in accordance with 2018 International Fire Code 319.
