  - a. Introduction of New Members
    - i. Mr. Polen asked all present to introduce themselves. Afterwards, he gave a quick introduction to Main Street and the Four Point Approach.
  - b. S.C. Humanities Festival - Pam Ward, Speaker
    - i. Pamela Herndon of the Moncks Corner chapter of the Daughters of American Revolution spoke and introduced Ms. Ward. The S.C. Humanities Festival is a festival that happens annually in various S.C. cities. Ms. Ward helped organize the festival in 2014 when the event was held in Summerville. The DAR plans to bring the event to Moncks Corner in 2020 and would like the support of the Town.
