Acknowledgement	<p>I acknowledge that any false or misleading statement, accusation, or allegation made herein may subject me to civil liability or criminal prosecution. I acknowledge that making a false report to the Moncks Corner Police Department (MCPD) is a violation of law as follows:</p> <p><u>Moncks Corner Municipal Ordinance 20-213</u> No person shall knowingly make or file or cause to be made or filed a false or misleading report, allegation or complaint with the police department.</p> <p>**Violations of Municipal Ordinances are punishable by a \$500 fine plus associated court costs and/or 30 days in jail.</p> <p><u>Section 16-17-722 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended</u> (A) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly file a false police report.</p> <p>(B) A person who violates subsection (A) by falsely reporting a felony is guilty of a felony and upon conviction must be imprisoned for not more than five years or fined not more than one thousand dollars, or both.</p> <p>(C) A person who violates subsection (A) by falsely reporting a misdemeanor is guilty of a misdemeanor and must be imprisoned not more than thirty days or fined not more than five hundred dollars, or both.</p> <p>(D) In imposing a sentence under this section, the judge may require the offender to pay restitution to the investigating agency to offset costs incurred in investigating the false police report.</p> <p>I acknowledge that it may become necessary during the course of the investigation of my complaint(s) for me to meet with member(s) of MCPD to be interviewed. I acknowledge that in the event my allegation and the explanation provided by the accused employee do not coincide, I may be asked to submit to a polygraph examination conducted by a certified examiner licensed by the State Law Enforcement Division (SLED) at the expense of MCPD. I acknowledge that the Chief of Police will not direct any MCPD employee submit to a polygraph examination until I have so submitted to and successfully completed an examination.</p>
